

#### "You were not willing!"

### Luke 13:33-35

Verse 34 – "…you were not willing"

<u>Jesus came to SAVE people from their sin!</u> John 3:16-17 / Matthew 1:21 / I Peter 2:24 / 2 Corinthians 5:21 / Acts 4:12 / Romans 5:8

### Jesus came to give LIFE! John 10:10

# 1. Their city killed the prophets (God's Word) sent to them by God!

- Verse 33
- Most all of the prophets that God sent to the Jewish people were murdered by the Jewish people...not by foreign enemies!
- Jesus points out that He is on the journey to Jerusalem to die! "Nevertheless, I <u>MUST GO</u> on my way today and tomorrow and the day following, for it cannot be that a prophet should perish away from Jerusalem."
- Remember in Luke 9:51 "He set his face to go to Jerusalem."
- Jesus set out to go to the cross and never looked back! This was the <u>turning point</u> of His ministry! Galilee was no longer his base of operation! <u>Jesus was DETERMINED to go to</u> <u>the Cross for us</u>!
- Hebrews 12:2 "Looking to JESUS, the Author and Finisher of our faith, who for the JOY that was set before Him <u>endured the Cross</u>, <u>despising its shame</u>..."
- <u>Why Joy???</u> Because, when He was on the cross, <u>He SAW your face and mine</u>! <u>He did it</u> for you! <u>He did it for me</u>! <u>He died for us!</u>
- Back to verse 34 <u>they murdered those that God sent</u>! God sent Jesus, His One and only Son, and they murdered Him too!
- People have been killing God's men and women ever since sin entered this world!

## Remember...it started with Cain killing Abel! Abel brought his BEST to God!

- I Kings 18:4 & 13 the evil Jezebel was murdering the prophets of God and Obadiah hid them.
- I kings 19:2 Jezebel was trying to kill the prophet Elijah.
- Nehemiah 9:26 killed the prophets of God in Nehemiah's day.
- 2 Kings 6:31 trying to kill Elijah's protégé Elisha.
- Jeremiah 38:4 trying to kill the prophet Jeremiah.

- Matthew 23:35 they murdered Zechariah and many more.
- The Book of Acts Stephen and the Apostles murdered.
- Hebrews 1:1-2 it is very clear that <u>WE have the Word of God today</u>, <u>our Bible</u>, and <u>WE</u> are God's prophets today as <u>WE speak and preach God's Word the Holy Bible</u>.
- I Thessalonians 2:15 "<u>against humanity</u> / <u>all Men</u>..." it will not stop! Anyone who declares the Word of God is a target for evil! (<u>work against / oppose</u>)
- Your own city and town will turn against you at times...you keep preaching the Truth!
- The reminder today is that WE are not ashamed of the Gospel of Jesus! Romans 1:16
- Verse 34 "the city that kills its prophets and stones those who are sent to it!"
- A city and town can turn on a believer very quick who is making a stand for the Truth!

## 2. O Jerusalem, Jerusalem!

- Verse 34
- This is the most powerful and compassionate cry over a city!
- Jesus references here a hen and her chicks! A mother hen will gather her chicks by spreading her wings and the chicks come under the wings for closeness and protection!
- Jesus wanted all of Jerusalem to be close to Him and to choose Him as their Lord and Savior! He wanted them to <u>not be</u> murderers, prideful, disobedient and living for themselves!
- <u>In 70 A.D.</u>, the Romans completely destroyed Jerusalem! <u>Why?</u> God's judgment against Jerusalem for <u>NOT choosing Jesus</u> and <u>living for Him</u>! Jesus tried to warn them and save them, but they chose to ignore His warnings!
- Verse 34 "<u>and you were not willing!</u>" (you wouldn't let me)
- This literally translates in the Original Greek "<u>I willed</u>, <u>but you willed not</u>."
- This is a choice! This is a choice to continue to live your own way, to love your own sin and to choose to IGNORE and REJECT Jesus and His Word!
- Verse 35 "<u>Behold your house is forsaken</u>!" (Abandoned) Jesus pronounces the judgment!
- Luke 19:41 Jesus one more time <u>WEEPS</u> over the city of Jerusalem and its people!
- They chose to reject Jesus and His Word! They rejected Him! His words! His life!
- Today, I believe Jesus is saying the same thing! "O West Plains, West Plains!"
- <u>Why</u> do you love your pride and sin? <u>Why</u> do you continue to abuse children, love your sexual immorality, addictions, promote and have sinful events! <u>Why</u>?
- Why do you take your freewill and choose evil and darkness?
- The thing that Jesus is looking for is found Acts 17:30-31!
- He is the SAME God who will save! But, He is the SAME God who will Judge!
