

"The Lost Sheep!"

Luke 15:1-7

<u>The setting</u>: Tax collectors and sinners that were in the area came to listen to Jesus! Jesus was getting ready to share His true heartbeat once again...<u>Salvation</u>!

- Yet, who is it that HATES the fact that Jesus is trying to reach out to people that are away from Him? <u>The Pharisees and the Scribes!</u>
- <u>Understand this one thing</u>: When Jesus reached the lost...they were willing to repent and change! <u>He NEVER affirmed any sinful lifestyle to continue! Never!</u>

1. Tax collectors, sinners and the Pharisees!

- Luke 15:1-3
- What the Pharisees and Scribes <u>continued to ignore</u> the very humble truths Jesus shared with them about this life and eternity (<u>Luke 14:1-34</u>)!
- Jesus has a very difficult message to follow <u>Luke 14:25-35</u>! It is the <u>ultimate choice</u> of surrender to Him and His way or not! Yet, these sinners and tax collectors are listening!
- Tax collectors and Gentile's were the outcasts of society! While these outcasts were listening to Him, changing their lives (<u>Matthew the Tax Collector is now a disciple</u>!), the Pharisees are more determined to kill Jesus!
- <u>They complained!</u> Luke 15:2 = <u>murmured greatly</u> through the crowds (making a scene with their snobbery)! "This man receives sinners!"
- How does Jesus handle this...

2. Jesus tells the Parable of the lost sheep!

- Luke 15:3
- Luke 15:4 "What man of you..."
- Jesus pinpoints this story right at the Pharisees again! See, Jesus was known to talk with sinners in Luke 7:34 / Luke 15:2! He wanted them to come, listen and repent!
- This Parable, right off the bat, shows that <u>God is taking the initiative to reach the sinner!</u>
 (Jewish rabbi's believed and taught that God would receive the sinner who sought out Him and His forgiveness earnestly)
- But here, God is the One seeking the sinner! Luke 19:10!!!!!

- This is why Jesus came down from Heaven to Earth! Philippians 2:5-11!
- <u>Jesus LEFT Heaven to save humanity!</u> Can the Pharisees not LEAVE their group and religious traditions and ways behind and go find the lost???
- Luke 15:4 "...if he has lost 1 of them, does he not leave the 99 in the open country, and go after the 1 that is lost, until he FINDS it?"
- <u>The shepherd</u> in the Middle East culture was <u>responsible</u> and <u>obligated to his Master</u> to make sure that not 1 sheep was lost, killed or injured! It must be found!
- Jesus is the <u>Good Shepherd</u> (<u>John 10</u>)! <u>This is why He came to give His life</u>! <u>To find the lost</u>!!!
- See, a shepherd was not and is not the Master! <u>Jesus is!</u>
- A shepherd is put in charge of the sheep to watch over, help guide and feed / water! Same today in the local church!
- This is why you have Pastors/Shepherds in the church to help the congregation (sheep) grow, be equipped and mature...yet Jesus is the Head!!!

3. Rejoice!

- What is the response of finding the 1 lost sheep? Luke 15:5 "...rejoicing!"
- Luke 15:6 "Rejoice with me..."
- Luke 15:7 "...there will be more joy in Heaven over one sinner who repents..."
- What should the local church look like? A PEOPLE and PLACE of JOY!!!!!
- A person was HELL BOUND and was rescued!
- A person was headed towards JUDGMENT for ETERNITY and was rescued!
- Do you have the JOY and EXCITEMENT over reaching that 1 person that is away from Jesus? If so...GO!!!!! If not...READ these stories and PRAY that God would give you His heart!
- This is the HEARTBEAT of Jesus! To seek and save those who are lost! Luke 19:10

Close: Don't end up like a Pharisee or Scribe!

- Luke 15:7
- Jesus makes it crystal clear to the Pharisees and all of the religious people listening to Him! He came to reach EVERYONE! Not just the Jews! Romans 3:23 & 29
- Romans 11:20-23 & 25 The Jews brought this on themselves by rejecting Jesus! But, verse 26 gives the Jews hope again! Israel still has hope!
- Acts 14:27 / Acts 15:7-9 / Acts 28:28
- <u>The Pharisees REFUSED to repent!</u> Jesus once again shows them that the Gentiles, tax collectors and all sinners <u>who believe</u>, <u>receive</u> and <u>follow</u> Him will be saved!
- Instead of having the bitterness and jealousy towards the people that Jesus is saving...be a part of this Great Salvation!!!
- Join in and repent, and rejoice and go reach people for Jesus Christ!
- The heartbeat of Jesus is that we EACH ONE REACH ONE!
